Mental Health Tip of the Week

Let's create a calming corner at home! Here are steps you can take to create an area your child can use to reset while experiencing big emotions. 1. Partner with your child to decide on a location that's in a safe, distraction-free spot. Let your child decide how they would like to set up the space. 2. Provide expectations for using this space. This helps to ensure that the space is not being used to avoid responsibilities. Teach your child how to use coping skills and how long it should take to reset. 3. Use this spot as a tool, not a punishment. If it is seen as a "time-out" spot, your child may be resistant to using it. Encourage your child to use the corner by saying something like "I wonder if you might feel better if you hung out in your calming corner for a little bit. What do you think?" 4. Items to include in the space may be a comfy chair or blanket, sand timer, calming jar from my tip at the end of January, fidget toys, coloring pages, or anything else that may help your child calm down. Be sure not to add too much in the corner, which may overwhelm your child.
